□ **Module 1: IS Audit Process (10 %)**

Provide IS audit services in accordance with IS audit standards, guidelines, and best practices to assist the organization in ensuring that its information technology and business systems are protected and controlled.

□ **Module 2: IT Governance (15 %)**

To provide assurance that the organization has the structure, policies, accountability, mechanisms, and monitoring practices in place to achieve the requirements of corporate governance of IT.

□ **Module 3: Systems and Infrastructure Lifecycle (16 %)**

To provide assurance that the management practices for the development/acquisition, testing, implementation, maintenance, and disposal of systems and infrastructure will meet the organization's objectives.

□ **Module 4: IT Service Delivery and Support (14 %)**

To provide assurance that the IT service management practices will ensure the delivery of the level of services required to meet the organization's objectives.

□ **Module 5: Protection of Information Assets (31 %)**

To provide assurance that the security architecture (policies, standards, procedures, and controls) ensures the confidentiality, integrity, and availability of information assets.

□ **Module 6: Business Continuity and Disaster Recovery (14 %)**

To provide assurance that in the event of a disruption, the business continuity and disaster recovery processes will ensure the timely resumption of IT services while minimizing the business impact.

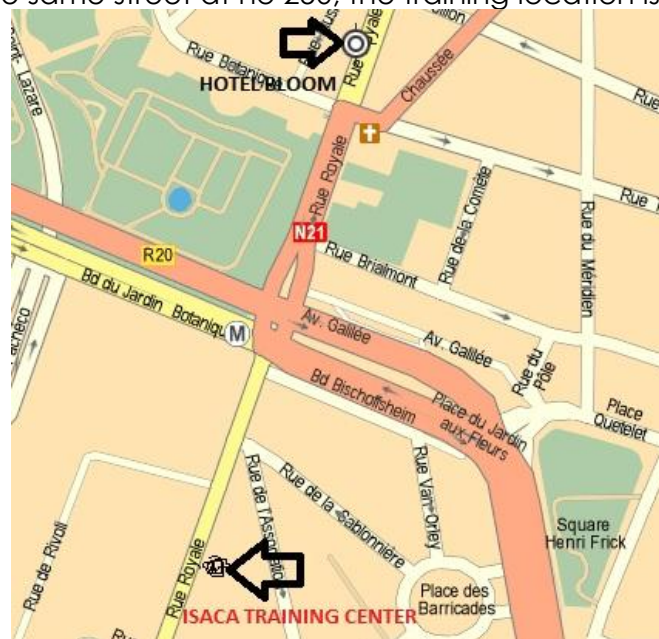
Location

ISACA CISA Exam Boot Camp - Frequently Asked Questions

Why should I attend a 3 day exam preparation course on CISA in Brussels?

1. This official ISACA boot camp will force you during 3 full days to focus on the CISA exam away from your office and desk.
2. You will be able to exchange remarks and experiences with ISACA CISA instructors and other CISA participants.
3. You will solve at least 150 exam sample questions in class.
4. You will learn valuable tips and tricks on the CISA exam.
5. You will meet other CISA exam participants with whom you can stay in touch after the course.
6. This boot camp is very interactive in class, so all participants will learn also how other potential CISA exam participants solve CISA questions
7. You will go home after this boot camp with many more sample questions to test yourself between the boot camp and the real exam.

Is there 1 combined registration process for the ISACA CISA exam and the ISACA CISA Exam Boot Camp?

No, these are 2 separate registration processes.

1. The **ISACA CISA EXAM** registration must be done via ISACA Headquarters in Chicago (www.isaca.org/CISA).
2. The registration for the **ISACA CISA Exam Boot camp** must be done via ISACA Belgium Chapter in Brussels (www.isaca.be).

A combined registration is not possible!

When is the ISACA CISA exam?

SATURDAY morning 9th of June 2012!

When should I register for the ISACA CISA exam?

There is an early bird registration for the CISA exam :

BEFORE WEDNESDAY 8th of February 2012.

You should register before the final closing date for the CISA exam :

BEFORE WEDNESDAY 4th of April 2012.

(so before the CISA Exam Boot camp in Brussels starts!!!)

ISACA CISA Exam Boot Camp - Frequently Asked Questions

Is following this ISACA CISA Exam Boot Camp sufficient for me to pass this exam successfully?

No, because any ISACA exam is a 100% individual challenge.

No, you will need to continue to rehearse the course materials and the sample questions after the boot camp until the exam on Saturday.

No, because the CISA exam is not a “know by heart” exam, but an exam with multiple choice questions testing your practical knowledge and experience as a Chief Information Security Officer.

Why is this ISACA CISA Exam Boot Camp relatively cheap (less than 350 euro for ISACA / IIA members per training day with proper training materials by experienced CISA trainers)?

ISACA Belgium vzw is a not-for-profit organisation and is part of ISACA International. We believe that it is our duty to potential CISA certified people to help them get the proper official preparation at the lowest cost possible.

Is passing the CISA exam sufficient to become certified as CISA?

No, in order to obtain your official ISACA CISA certification you will need to:

1. Pass the ISACA CISA exam (200 multiple choice questions) successfully.
2. Find three persons who are confirming your experience in information security.
3. Apply officially for CISA certification towards ISACA International.
4. Pay the CISA certification fee.
5. Confirm that you are going to invest at least 120 hours every three years in continuous professional education.
6. Confirm that you will follow the ISACA Code of Conduct for certified professionals.

What is the date of the next CISA exam after June 2012?

The next exam after June 2012 will be administered on 8th of December 2012. Registration for the December 2012 exam will start mid-June 2012.
