Introduced in 2010, the CRISC™ designation is designed for professionals who have hands-on experience with risk identification, assessment, and evaluation; risk response; risk monitoring; IS control design and implementation; and IS control monitoring and maintenance.

The CRISC designation will not only certify professionals who have knowledge and experience identifying and evaluating entity-specific risk, but also aid them in helping enterprises accomplish business objectives by designing, implementing, monitoring and maintaining risk-based, efficient and effective IS controls.

### What you will learn:

The official ISACA exam boot camp materials are based on the **CRISC™ job practice** as defined by ISACA. These areas and statements were developed by the CRISC Task Force and represent a job practice analysis of the work performed in risk identification, assessment, evaluation, response and monitoring and in the design, implementation, monitoring, and maintenance of IS controls. These statements and domains were the result of extensive research and feedback from risk and information systems control subject matter experts and validated by prominent industry leaders, subject matter experts and industry practitioners around the globe.

The **Job Practice** domains and task and knowledge statements are as follows:

Domain 1—Risk Identification, Assessment and Evaluation (31%)

Identify, assess and evaluate risk to enable the execution of the enterprise risk management strategy.

Domain 2—Risk Response (17%)

Develop and implement risk responses to ensure that risk factors and events are addressed in a cost-effective manner and in line with business objectives.

Domain 3—Risk Monitoring (17%)

Monitor risk and communicate information to the relevant stakeholders to ensure the continued effectiveness of the enterprise's risk management strategy.

Domain 4—Information Systems Control Design and Implementation (17%)

Design and implement information systems controls in alignment with the organization's risk appetite and tolerance levels to support business objectives

Domain 5—IS Control Monitoring and Maintenance (18%)

Monitor and maintain information systems controls to ensure they function effectively and efficiently.

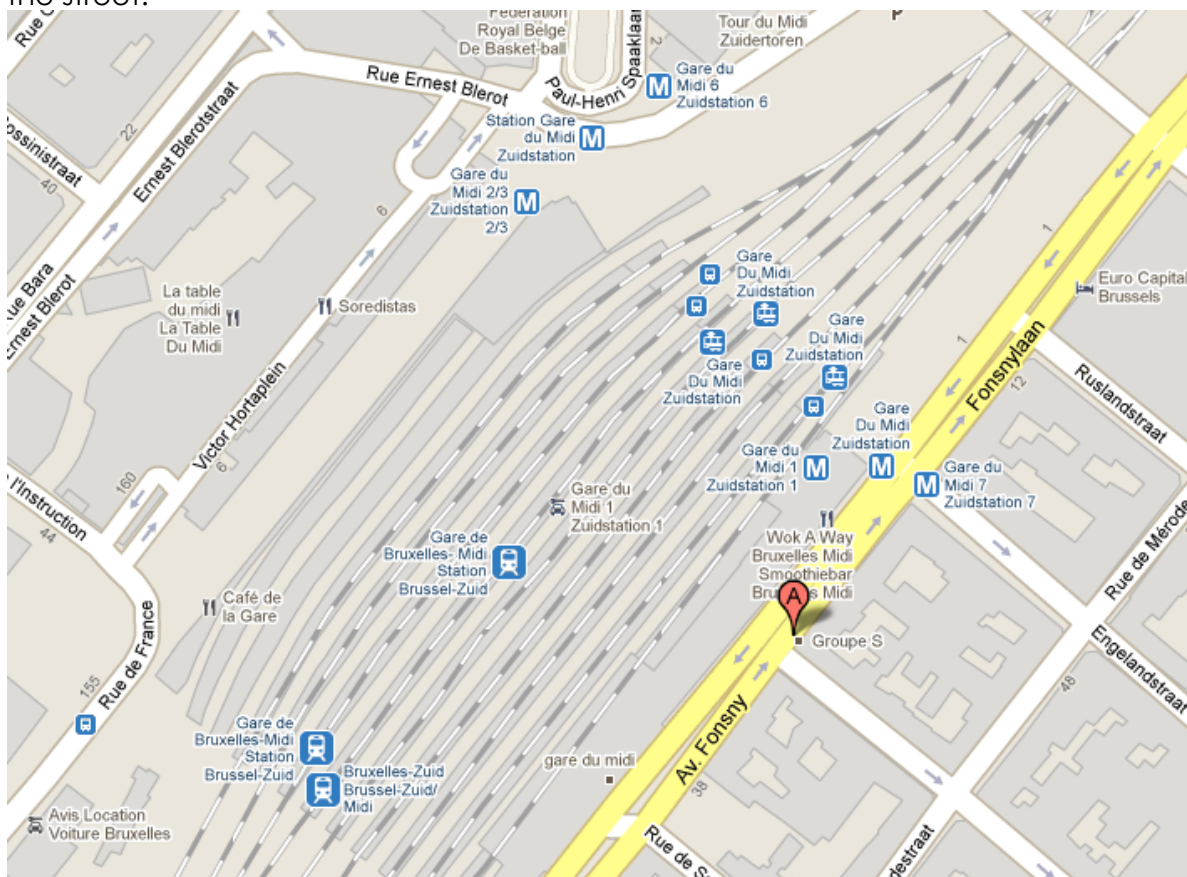
### **Transportation arrangements :**

We highly recommend using our excellent Belgian public transportation (train).  
When arriving at the Brussels Zaventem airport : go towards the trains at level -2 after passing customs in the arrival gate.

Take the train from Brussels Zaventem Airport towards Brussels-Midi train station: you can pay either upon arrival at the desk of the train station at level -2 before going to the correct train platform, or you can pay online or on the train with VISA, MASTERCARD or AMEX. It is approximately 10 euro (one way).

Once you arrive in Brussels-Midi station, follow signs "Fonsnylaan" and it is just across the street.



On Wednesday evening at the end of the CRISC Exam Boot Camp, you can take the train from there directly to the airport in less than 30 minutes.  
The training staff can help you order your train ticket online before you leave the hotel (you only need a credit card).



## CRISC Exam Boot Camp Frequently Asked Questions

### Why should I attend a 3 day exam preparation course on CRISC?

1. This ISACA official boot camp will force you during 3 full days to focus on the CRISC exam away from your office and desk.
2. You will be able to exchange remarks and experiences with ISACA CRISC instructors and other CRISC participants.
3. You will solve at least 150 exam sample questions in class.
4. You will learn valuable tips and tricks on the CRISC exam.
5. You will meet other CRISC exam participants with whom you can stay in touch after the course.
6. This boot camp is very interactive in class, so all participants will learn also how other potential CRISC exam participants solve CRISC questions
7. You will go home after this boot camp with many more sample questions to test yourself between the boot camp and the real exam.

### Is there 1 combined registration process for the ISACA CRISC exam and the ISACA CRISC Exam Boot Camp?

**No, these are 2 separate registration processes.**

1. The **ISACA CRISC EXAM registration** must be done via ISACA Headquarters in Chicago ([www.isaca.org/CRISC](http://www.isaca.org/CRISC)).
2. The registration for the **ISACA CRISC Exam Boot camp** must be done via ISACA Belgium Chapter in Brussels ([www.isaca.be](http://www.isaca.be)).

A combined registration is not possible!

### When is the ISACA CRISC exam?

**SATURDAY morning 9<sup>th</sup> of June 2012!**

### When should I register for the ISACA CRISC exam?

There is an early bird registration for the CRISC exam :

**BEFORE WEDNESDAY 8<sup>th</sup> of February 2012.**

You should register before the final closing date for the CRISC exam :

**BEFORE WEDNESDAY 4<sup>th</sup> of April 2012.**

(so before the CRISC Exam Boot camp in Brussels starts!!!)



## ISACA CRISC Exam Boot Camp - Frequently Asked Questions

### **Is following this ISACA CRISC Exam Boot Camp sufficient for me to pass this exam successfully?**

No, because any ISACA exam is a 100% individual challenge.

No, you will need to continue to rehearse the course materials and the sample questions after the boot camp until the exam on Saturday.

No, because the CRISC exam is not a “know by heart” exam, but an exam with multiple choice questions testing your practical knowledge and experience as a Risk Manager.

### **Why is this ISACA CRISC Exam Boot Camp relatively cheap (less than 350 euro for ISACA / IIA members per training day with proper training materials by experienced CRISC trainers who actually did pass the CRISC exam)?**

ISACA Belgium vzw is a not-for-profit organisation and is part of ISACA International. We believe that it is our duty to potential CRISC certified people to help them get the proper official preparation at the lowest cost possible.

### **Is passing the CRISC exam sufficient to become certified as CRISC?**

No, in order to obtain your official ISACA CRISC certification you will need to:

1. Pass the ISACA CRISC exam (120 multiple choice questions) successfully.
2. Find three persons who are confirming your experience in IT governance.
3. Apply officially for CRISC certification towards ISACA International.
4. Pay the CRISC certification fee.
5. Confirm that you are going to invest at least 120 hours every three years in continuous professional education.
6. Confirm that you will follow the ISACA Code of Conduct for certified professionals.

### **What is the date of the next CRISC exam after June 2012?**

The next exam after June 2012 will be administered on 8<sup>th</sup> of December 2012. Registration for the December 2012 exam will start mid-June 2012.
