The ISACA CISM exam covers 5 information security management areas, each of which is further defined and detailed through Tasks & Knowledge statements. These areas and statements were developed by the ISACA CISM Certification Board and represent a job practice analysis of the work performed by information security managers as validated by prominent industry leaders, subject matter experts and industry practitioners. The following is a brief description of these areas, their definitions and approximate percentage of test questions allocated to each area.

What you will learn:

Module 1: Information Security Governance (23 %)

Establish and maintain a framework to provide assurance that information security strategies are aligned with business objectives and consistent with applicable laws and regulations.

Module 2: Information Risk Management (22 %)

Identify and manage information security risks to achieve business objectives.

Module 3: Information Security Program Development (17 %)

Create and maintain a program to implement the information security strategy.

Module 4: Information Security Operational Management (24 %)

Oversee and direct information security activities to execute the information security program.

Module 5: Incident / Continuity Management & Response (14 %)

Plan, develop and manage a capability to detect, respond to and recover from information security incidents.

Transportation arrangements :

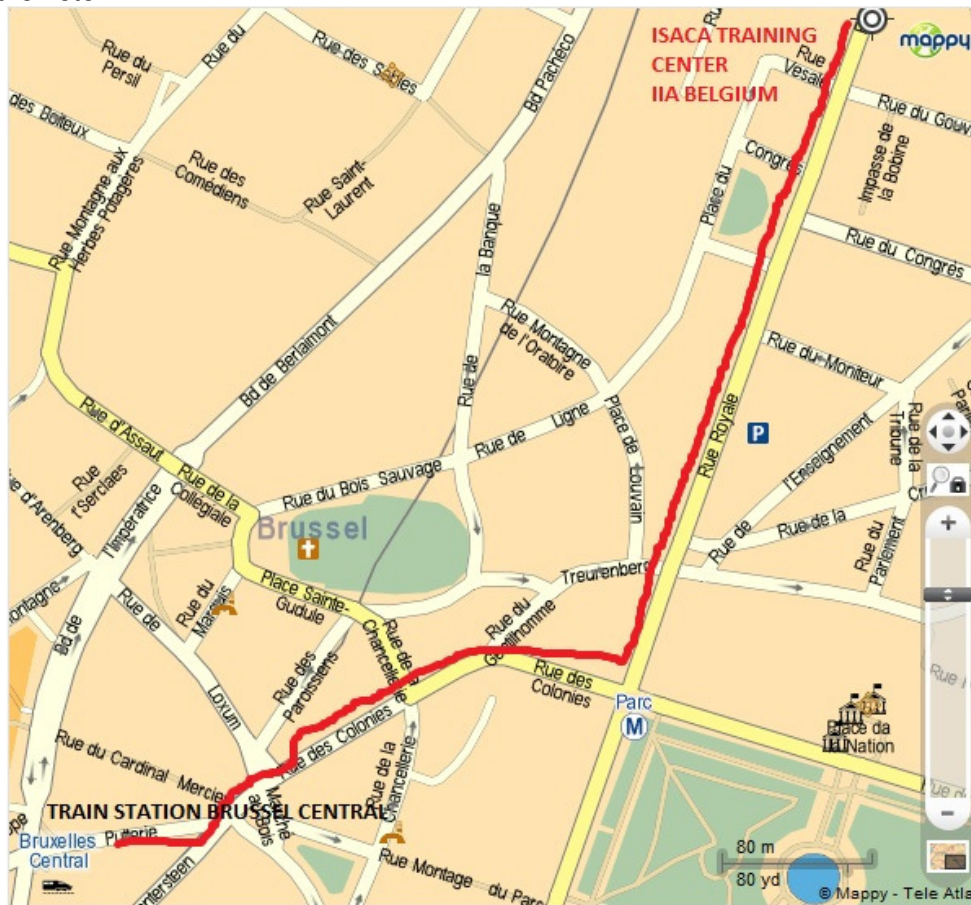
We highly recommend using our excellent Belgian public transportation (train).

When arriving at the Brussels Zaventem airport : go towards the trains at level -2 after passing customs in the arrival gate.

Take the train from Brussels Zaventem Airport towards Brussels-Central train station: you can pay either upon arrival at the desk of the train station at level -2 before going to the correct train platform, or you can pay online or on the train with VISA, MASTERCARD or AMEX. It is 10,20 euro (one way).

Once you arrive in Brussels-Central station, it is either a 10 minute walk or a very short taxi ride to the hotel.



On Friday evening at the end of the CISM Exam Boot Camp, you can walk to the train station and from there directly to the airport. The training staff on site can help you order your train ticket online before you leave the ISACA training center (you only need a credit card).



ISACA CISM Exam Boot Camp - Frequently Asked Questions

Is there 1 combined registration process for the ISACA CISM exam and the ISACA CISM Exam Boot Camp?

No, there are 2 separate registration processes.

1. The ISACA CISM EXAM registration must be done via ISACA Headquarters in Chicago (www.isaca.org/CISM).
2. The registration for the ISACA CISM Exam Boot camp must be done via ISACA Belgium Chapter in Brussels (www.isaca.be).

A combined registration is not possible!

When is the ISACA CISM exam?

SATURDAY morning 11th of June 2011!

When should I register for the ISACA CISM exam?

There is an early bird registration for the CISM exam :

BEFORE WEDNESDAY 9th of February 2011.

You should register before the final closing date for the CISM exam :

BEFORE WEDNESDAY 6th of April 2011.

(so before the CISM Exam Boot camp in Brussels starts)

Why should I attend a 3 day exam preparation course on CISM in Brussels?

1. This boot camp will force you during 3 full days to focus on the CISM exam.
2. You will be able to exchange remarks and experiences with ISACA CISM instructors and other CISM participants.
3. You will receive the official ISACA CISM EXAM MANUAL.
4. You will solve at least 150 exam sample questions in class.
5. You will learn valuable tips and tricks on the CISM exam.
6. You will meet other CISM exam participants with whom you can stay in touch.
7. This boot camp is off site in Brussels away from your office and desk.
8. This boot camp will be very interactive in class, so you will learn also how other potential CISM exam participants solve CISM questions
9. You will go home after this boot camp with many more sample questions to test yourself between the boot camp and the real exam.



ISACA CISM Exam Boot Camp - Frequently Asked Questions

Is following this ISACA CISM Exam Boot Camp sufficient for me to pass this exam successfully?

No, because any ISACA exam is a 100% individual challenge.

No, you will need to continue to rehearse the course materials and the sample questions after the boot camp until the exam on Saturday.

No, because the CISM exam is not a “know by heart” exam, but an exam with multiple choice questions testing your practical knowledge and experience as a Chief Information Security Officer.

Why is this ISACA CISM Exam Boot Camp relatively cheap (less than 1.200 euro for ISACA / IIA members for 3 full days of training with proper training materials by experienced CISM trainers)?

ISACA Belgium vzw is a not-for-profit organisation and is part of ISACA International. We believe that it is our duty to potential CISM certified people to help them get the proper official preparation at the lowest cost possible.

Is passing the CISM exam sufficient to become certified as CISM?

No, in order to obtain your official ISACA CISM certification you will need to:

1. Pass the ISACA CISM exam (200 multiple choice questions) successfully.
2. Find three persons who are confirming your experience in information security.
3. Apply officially for CISM certification towards ISACA International.
4. Pay the CISM certification fee.
5. Confirm that you are going to invest at least 120 hours every three years in continuous professional education.
6. Confirm that you will follow the ISACA Code of Conduct for certified professionals.

What is the date of the next CISM exam after June 2011?

The next exam after June 2011 will be administered in December 2011.

Registration for the December 2011 exam will start mid-August 2011.
