The June 2011 exam will be the first CISA exam based on the new 2011 CISA Common Body of Knowledge.

### What you will learn:

**Module 1: The Process of Auditing Information Systems (14 %)**

Provide audit services in accordance with IT audit standards, guidelines, and best practices to assist the organization in protecting and controlling business information systems.

**Module 2: Governance and Management of IT (14 %)**

Provide assurance that the necessary leadership and organization structure, processes, policies, accountability mechanisms, and monitoring practices are in place to achieve objectives and to support the organization's strategy.

**Module 3: IS Acquisition, Development and Implementation (19 %)**

Provide assurance that the practices for the acquisition, development, testing, implementation, and maintenance of information systems meet the organization's strategies and objectives.

**Module 4: Information Systems Operations, Maintenance and Support (23 %)**

Provide assurance that the processes for information systems operations, maintenance and support meet the organization's strategies and objectives.

**Module 5: Protection of Information Assets (30 %)**

Provide assurance that the organization's security policies, standards, procedures and controls ensure the confidentiality, integrity and availability of information assets.

## ISACA CISA Exam Boot Camp - Frequently Asked Questions

### Is there 1 combined registration process for the ISACA CISA exam and the ISACA CISA Exam Boot Camp?

No, there are 2 separate registration processes.

1. The ISACA CISA EXAM registration must be done via ISACA Headquarters in Chicago ([www.isaca.org/CISA](http://www.isaca.org/CISA)).
2. The registration for the ISACA CISA Exam Boot camp must be done via ISACA Belgium Chapter in Brussels ([www.isaca.be](http://www.isaca.be)).

A combined registration is not possible!

### When is the ISACA CISA exam?

**SATURDAY morning 11<sup>th</sup> of June 2011!**

### When should I register for the ISACA CISA exam?

There is an early bird registration for the CISA exam :

**BEFORE WEDNESDAY 9<sup>th</sup> of February 2011.**

You should register before the final closing date for the CISA exam :

**BEFORE WEDNESDAY 6<sup>th</sup> of April 2011.**

(so before the CISA Exam Boot camp in Brussels starts)

### Why should I attend a 3 day exam preparation course on CISA in Brussels?

1. This boot camp will force you during 3 full days to focus on the CISA exam.
2. You will be able to exchange remarks and experiences with ISACA CISA instructors and other CISA participants.
3. You will receive the official ISACA CISA EXAM MANUAL.
4. You will solve at least 150 exam sample questions in class.
5. You will learn valuable tips and tricks on the CISA exam.
6. You will meet other CISA exam participants with whom you can stay in touch.
7. This boot camp is off site in Brussels away from your office and desk.
8. This boot camp will be very interactive in class, so you will learn also how other potential CISA exam participants solve CISA questions
9. You will go home after this boot camp with many more sample questions to test yourself between the boot camp and the real exam.

## **ISACA CISA Exam Boot Camp - Frequently Asked Questions**

### **Is following this ISACA CISA Exam Boot Camp sufficient for me to pass this exam successfully?**

No, because any ISACA exam is a 100% individual challenge.

No, you will need to continue to rehearse the course materials and the sample questions after the boot camp until the exam on Saturday.

No, because the CISA exam is not a “know by heart” exam, but an exam with multiple choice questions testing your practical knowledge and experience as a Chief Information Security Officer.

### **Why is this ISACA CISA Exam Boot Camp relatively cheap (less than 1.200 euro for ISACA / IIA members for 3 full days of training with proper training materials by experienced CISA trainers)?**

ISACA Belgium vzw is a not-for-profit organisation and is part of ISACA International. We believe that it is our duty to potential CISA certified people to help them get the proper official preparation at the lowest cost possible.

### **Is passing the CISA exam sufficient to become certified as CISA?**

No, in order to obtain your official ISACA CISA certification you will need to:

1. Pass the ISACA CISA exam (200 multiple choice questions) successfully.
2. Find three persons who are confirming your experience in information security.
3. Apply officially for CISA certification towards ISACA International.
4. Pay the CISA certification fee.
5. Confirm that you are going to invest at least 120 hours every three years in continuous professional education.
6. Confirm that you will follow the ISACA Code of Conduct for certified professionals.

### **What is the date of the next CISA exam after June 2011?**

The next exam after June 2011 will be administered in December 2011.

Registration for the December 2011 exam will start after the June 2011 exam.
